
Installation Instructions Trombone Door



Installation Components

- White NG Silicone sealant
- No.6x10 Stainless Steel Screws (8)
- No.6x 38 Stainless Steel Screws (6)
- Screw Cover Caps white (8)
- Drip Seal (1m length)

Tools and Materials Required

- Drill
- No.1 Sq Drive Bit
- Spirit Level
- Pencil
- Tape Measure
- Flat Bladed Screwdriver
- 3.0 mm Drill Bit
- 4.5 mm Drill Bit
- Caulking Gun
- Cleaning Cloth
- Masking Tape



The Trombone Door can be installed either left or right hand hinged by simply rotating 180 degrees.


Important: The Door must always open outwards

Step 1 <u>Installing the Wall Receivers</u>


Place the Wall Receiver on the shower step. Using a spirit level ensure the Wall Receiver is plumb. Mark the position of the Wall Receiver on the wall. Repeat for the opposite side



Pre drill three equally spaced clearance holes (i.e. top, bottom and centre) in the Wall Receivers using a 4.5mm drill bit. Reposition the Wall Receivers onto the wall. Drill into the wall through the clearance holes using a 3.0mm drill bit. **N.B.** The holes preferably locate into a stud or nog. As an alternative, a toggler system can also be used.




Apply Silicone into the screw holes and secure the Wall Receivers to the walls using the No.6 x 38mm stainless steel screws.





Step 2 Installing the Trombone Door

Slide the Trombone door assembly together so it is at its minimum width



Determine which side the Trombone Door is to be hinged ensuring that the door opens outwards. Lift the Trombone Door onto the shower step and fully insert one side into a Wall Receiver. Expand the Door out so it fully engages into the opposite Wall Receiver.






Check that the Door Jambs are plumb

From the inside of the shower fix the Door to the Wall Receivers by drilling three 3mm holes down the Wall Receivers (top, bottom and centre). Drill through the Wall Receivers into the Door Jamb profiles.

Secure in place using No.6 x 10mm stainless steel screws. Cover the screw heads with the cover caps.

Repeat for opposite side.




From the inside of shower

Step 3 Securing the Head and Sills

From the inside of the shower drill a 3.0mm hole approximately 25mm in from the end of the Female Head and Sill sections and into the Male Head and Sill sections.

Secure the sections together using No.6 x 10 Stainless steel screws. Cover the screws heads with the cover caps.




Step 4 Adjusting the Trombone Door Glass


Slide the outside Clamp Block Covers off the Pivot Clamp Using a flat bladed screwdriver, adjust the door glass as required, by loosening the screws on each pivot block. Ensure that:


- The Magnetic door closing strips are aligned
- The lower edge of the Door glass is parallel to the Door Sill

Once the door adjustment is complete ensure the screws are retightened and reinstall the Clamp Block Covers

Trim and fit the Door Drip seal. The vertical blade of the drip seal will face to the inside of the shower

Step 5 Sealing the Trombone Door

Ensure all surfaces are cleaned with dry clean cloth.


From the **OUTSIDE ONLY**


- Seal Trombone Door to the Shower Step
- Seal the full length of the Wall Receivers to the Wall Liner

Note MASKING the area to be sealed will give a superior finish

IMPORTANT: DO NOT apply sealant to the inside of the shower







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
